We completed the following items with regards to the building:

- Continue to have the pest control come in.
- Trash is taken to the dump regularly.
- There was no cleaning of the Sanctuary in leu of the Christmas Party in December. The Sanctuary and Kitchen will be cleaned the second Saturday in January and possible the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday including the kid's space.
- We received an application for a volunteer but due to the covid-19 we are going to hold off on having that volunteer start.
- Spoke to the electrician in October. He was going to look at the front and give us a price for putting in a light at the door. And after 3 text messages and calls I have given up on him. Question on whether we can afford to have a light put in at this time. If so I will look at another electrician.
- There are some spots were painting is peeling in the Sanctuary above where Pastor Set. Do we have paint available to touch that up?
- Also, some of the flooring in the Sanctuary appear to be rising. Will keep an eye
  on this.
- We had to discontinue the making of sandwiches after church on Sunday. This
  has brought spiritual pain to some of the participants and we have tried to explain
  that this is for safety so that we can come together once we are ability to.

New Light MCC Hagerstown, MD Request for Funds

We appreciate the opportunity to share our ministries as well as our dreams for increasing their impact. The monies that you gift New Light will benefit those without in our community. We are a small congregation of 30 with a big heart for those struggling in poverty and often go without. This ministry has been a great blessing. We receive no grant money. We are fully supported by our members and friends. If you have any questions, please feel free to call me at (717)682-1873.

 New Light MCC is located in a high poverty area in which many homeless live on the streets nearby. We have attempted to meet the needs around us. No one is excluded. My wife and I live above the church and people will knock on the front door and she will try to find what they need.

We have a shelving unit outside our front door which we use to offer people food, hygiene items and clothes. We offer what is donated by church members and friends. Sometimes, we little to nothing to put in the box.

We also provide a meal two days a week along with clothes and hygiene items. We feed about 75 people each time or until run out of food. We are limited in the number of days because of limited funds. Hygiene items are expensive and often can only provide limited numbers.

Before Covid-19, we opened the doors of the church for people to come in and rest during the day.

Monies received would go to purchasing food for meals, for our food box, as well as hygiene items and items for when we open the church again.

We would love to upgrade to a commercial kitchen. Our biggest dream is to have enough money to provide for those needing food, hygiene items and other needs such as blankets, hats, gloves.

2. An event that we call Christmas Extravaganza is held in December in which 100 children and family who live at or below poverty, are invited to a Christmas party of giving and receiving. We offer, crafts, presents, a meal and visit from Santa. But the best is the kids get to pick out gifts for each family members. We then wrap them so they can take them home for Christmas day. We struggle each year to make sure we have enough money to provide all the items for this project.

Money is also needed for other parties and giveaways that we do such as Valentine's Day, Easter, a Summer picnic and Halloween. We always provide food at each of these events.

3. We have dreamed of creating a recorded LGBTO history of Washington County, MD. We have begun to gather information. Our need is equipment to facilitate this project. We are requesting \$9000 for a hardware upgrade to accomplish this as well as update our Facebook Live ministry. We live in a tri-state area and our outreach through Facebook is vital. During the Covid-19 pandemic, we have only been able to have those helping with the service attend since our sanctuary is so small. We are able to reach current members and also have been able to extend our reach outside our area. We were able to bring six new members from over 2 hours away in PA through our Facebook Live ministry.
