Not much new to report. The building cleaning this month focused on cleaning the refrigerators in the kitchen and the middle room, the Sanctuary and moping the floors.

Thanks to the person (Dee) that created the beautiful gardened fence. It's very catching with the flowers blooming. The flowers in the front also have caught the eyes of those we feed on Sundays.

The pest control guy came in Monday and will be back on October 20th. He reported that he made a stronger formula this month. We had two dead mice this past month and several crickets.

I have the list of items we were going to look at tackling one or two for this coming month.

- 1 Scrape the tape off the inside of the front windows and clean them properly.
- 2 Replace the stained ceiling panels.
- 3 Replace or just put new bulbs in the side lights in the sanctuary that are burned out.
- 4 Look above where the ceiling panels were wet and try to see where the leak is coming from.
- 5 The ac filter in the kitchen needs replaced.
- 6 The bathrooms toilet.
- 7 Upstairs attic storage needs lights again.
- 8 Clean and organize tables in the social hall and start to put things out for a future yard sale.
- 9 The window in the office where the ac is has structural problems.
- 10 All 3 crosses put back on the side of the building, or make sure the last one will stay up or take it down.
- 11 Do we want the screen door back on the side door again.
- 12 Install inexpensive security cameras.
- 13 Donate the books to the library
- 14 Paint the sanctuary
